Campus Representative

Student ambassadors represent the sixth form at various events, serving as the face of the sixth form to prospective students, parents and visitors.

Peer Mentor

They provide guidance and support to new and prospective students, helping them navigate campus life, academic studies and available resources.

Event Support

Ambassadors can assist in leading campus tours and open days and any other campus events, offering insights into student life.

Community Builder

They help foster a sense of community by engaging with students and staff, promoting inclusivity and involvement in campus activities.

Communication Liaison

Student ambassadors often act as a bridge between students and sixth form staff, providing feedback and voicing student concerns.

We'll keep in touch with a range of exciting activities and additional events that you can get involved in.

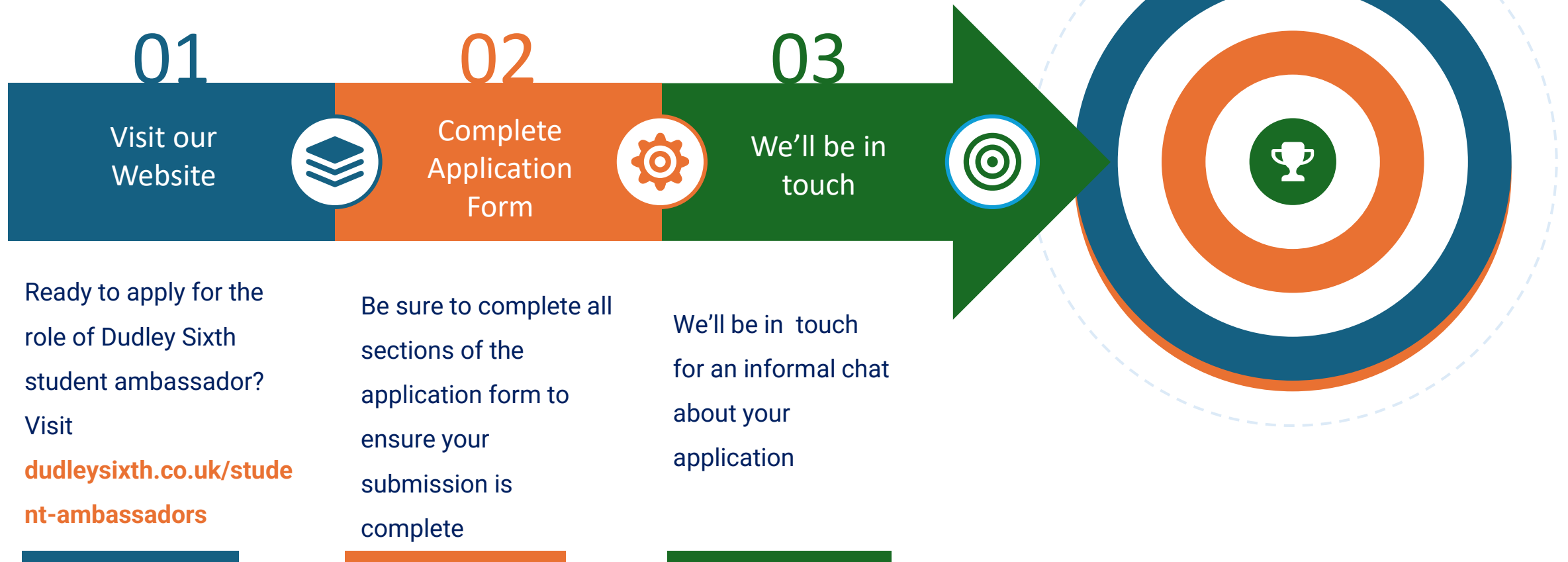

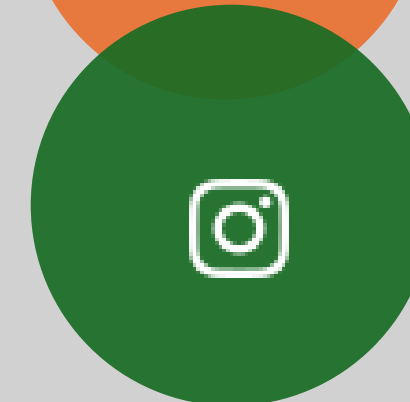

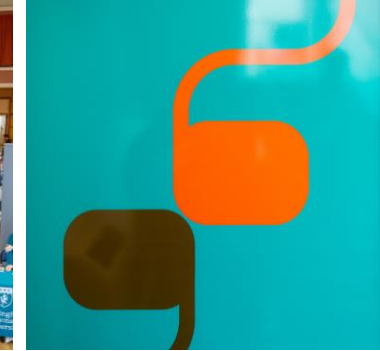
